Narrative

• Minnesota continues to publish the quarterly *Snare the Drug Impaired* newsletter that is sent to over 1000 recipients.

• Over 41,000 arrests for DWI were made in 2007 (a 13% increase from 2006). As of 28 April 2008, 690 of those arrests were for controlled substance. Minnesota's alcohol related fatalities dropped to the lowest level since 1984.

• Minnesota's 15th DRE School was held in April. With the certification of the 24 officers that attended that training, MN rose to the ranks of 159 DREs from 79 agencies.

• In 2007, the MN Bureau of Criminal Apprehension Forensic Science lab analyzed 235 urine samples that had been submitted for alcohol DWI (over .08 AC) to determine the prevalence of drugged driving. The lab found that 43% of the samples had drugs in addition to their .08 (+) AC. Additionally, they found that (in addition to alcohol) 72% tested positive for one drug, 20% for two, 7% for three and 1% for four.
